ORIGIN: Belgium, Spain

GENERAL The product shall be prepared from fresh sound raw material that is free from all toxic residues and taints and shall comply with all current UK/EU Food Legislation. The product is intended to be used as ingredient that is further processed and heat-treated before final consumption (minimum of +75°C for 30 seconds).

INGREDIENTS Celery 100% Declare as: Celery
(*Apium graveolens*)

PROCESSING Celery is harvested, trimmed, delivered to the factory. Each load is sampled and assessed for foreign material and physical defects. The load is then cleaned, inspected, sliced, blanched, cooled, frozen and filled into bulk palletainers. Frozen celery is sampled and assessed against specification. The palletainers are then labelled and transferred to the cold store, where they are stored at -18°C until required for packing.

PACKING During packing, the celery is inspected before weighing and filling into blue poly lined cartons. The cartons are Best Before and Production date coded, check weighed and metal detected, palletised and stretch wrapped before being returned to store at -18°C to await despatch to the UK at -18°C.

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DEFINITIONS OF DEFECTS

Clumps

These are where three or more slices are frozen together which cannot be readily separated without causing damage to the dice.

Foreign Material

This includes any material not derived from the celery plant or defined as EVM, such as insects, pieces of insects, wood, glass, stones, metal, sand, grit, plastic or any other material which will render the product unacceptable.

Extraneous Vegetable Matter (EVM)

Vegetable material derived from the celery plant other than the celery flesh e.g. pieces of leaf etc. Vegetable material not from the celery plant will be counted as Foreign material.

Oxidative Browning

These are slices which show light brown colouration caused by oxidation.

Blemishes

This includes celery slices that are blemished to the extent that the area affected is between 2mm and 6mm in diameter, either as a single blemish or an aggregate of blemishes on the same die. Blemishes less than 2mm in diameter shall be ignored.

Cut Size

These are slices which are 10 to 16mm between the cut surfaces.

Petiole Width

This is the width of the celery petiole.

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ORGANOLEPSIS (Carried out on a thawed sample.)

COLOUR Pale creamy yellow to light green.

FLAVOUR Full characteristic flavour typical of celery

TEXTURE Fairly uniform, flesh shall be firm without woodiness.

ANALYTICAL Product shall be blanched to give a negative peroxidase reaction (guaiaicol test) between 50 and 60 seconds.

WEIGHT CONTROL The product shall be packed to minimum weight.

METAL DETECTION All cartons shall be passed through a metal detector. The system shall be tested at least every 2 hours using ferrous, non-ferrous and stainless-steel test pieces.

BEST BEFORE DATE The product shall be twenty-four months following the month of packing. Minimum BB date on delivery: 6 months.

TRACEABILITY INFO Production date or Lot number printed on the label as well as customer order number and/or delivery date.

STORAGE CONDITIONS Keep frozen at - 18°C at all times.

CARTON LINERS Blue food grade polythene liner of a minimum thickness of 30µm.

CARTONS Corrugated fibreboard of glued construction, no metal staples to be used. Shall be sealed using blue adhesive tape.

SACKS Blue food grade polythene sack of a minimum thickness of 100 µm.
